Implementing ISO 45001:2018 - Changes from OHSAS 18001 on Occupational Health and Safety Management Systems (OHSMS)



About the Programme:

Health and safety in the workplace are the number one concern of most businesses, yet still deaths and injuries occur. Occupational Health and Safety management System (OHSMS) is a framework that allows an organization to consistently identify and control its health and safety risks, reduce the potential for incidents, help achieve compliance with health and safety legislation and continually improve its performance. OHSAS 18001 was being used as the Standard for Occupational Health and Safety Management System (OHSMS) the world over for certification, in the absence of any ISO Standard for the same.

ISO 45001 Standard on OHSMS has been published in March 2018. ISO 45001 sets the minimum standard of practice to protect employees worldwide. The Standard specifies requirements for an Occupational Health and Safety Management System, with guidance for its use, to enable an organization to proactively improve its OH&S performance in preventing injury and ill-health. With the publication of ISO 45001, certifications to OHSAS 18001, will no longer be valid after three years from the date of publication of ISO 45001.
